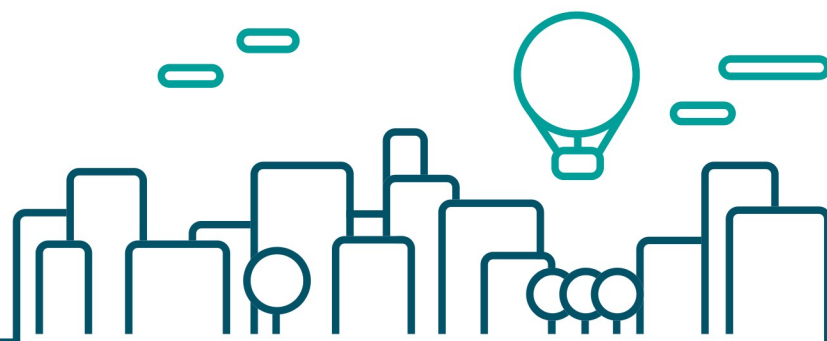

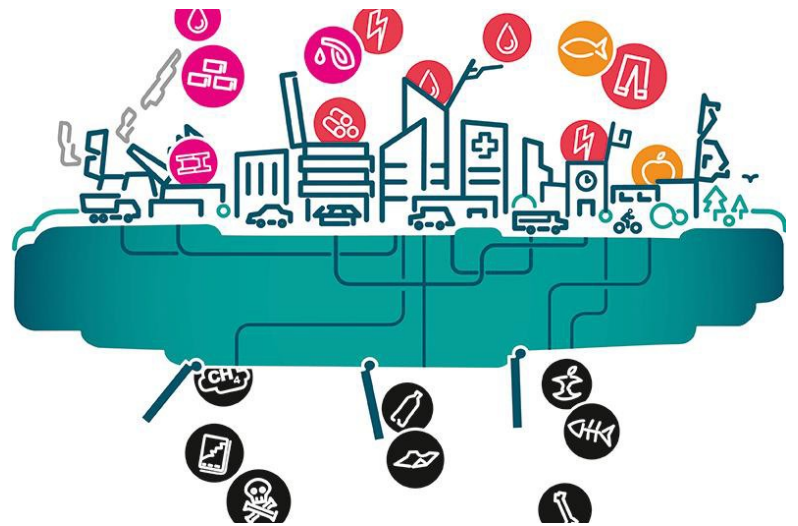

Introducing UrbanWINS

UrbanWINS seeks to develop and test methods for design and implementation of **eco-innovative strategic plans for waste prevention and management.**

It is an EU funded* three-year project which began in June 2016.

The Consortium

1.27 partners from 7 European countries

2. Heterogeneity: cities, universities, technological centres, NGOs, etc.

3. Added value: assures that the progresses made are directly linked to stakeholder engagement and mutual learning processes, and contributes to the achievement of resource efficiency and waste management objectives.



Approach

1. **In-depth analysis** of the urban waste management strategies in 24 cities in 6 EU countries (Austria, Italy, Portugal, Romania, Spain and Sweden) based on an ‘urban metabolism’ approach.
2. **Participation of stakeholders in urban agoras** (real and virtual ones) set up in the 8 pilot cities: Cremona, Torino and two cities part of the Metropolitan City of some (Italy), Bucharest (Romania), Leiria (Portugal), and Manresa & Sabadell (Spain).
3. **Development and testing** of the sustainability and innovation related recommendations and instruments for waste prevention and management.
