UrbanWINS is a three-year project funded by the Research and Innovation Programme Horizon 2020. The project, which started in June 2016, is analysing how cities consume resources and products, and how they eliminate the waste produced. Eight pilot cities across Europe have developed their Strategic Planning Frameworks for waste prevention and management and will now enter a piloting phase to test innovative, cross-sectoral and circular solutions co-built with all relevant stakeholders through a participatory process that led to their commitment to action.
