STRATEGIC FRAMEWORKS & LOCAL ACTION PLANS

- The 8 pilot cities have adopted the Strategic frameworks for waste prevention and management and the Local Strategic Action Plans
- **Strategic frameworks for waste prevention and management:** cross-sectoral, contain cities' objectives for the short/medium and long term
- **Local Strategic Action Plans:** detailed implementation plans accompanied by **evaluation plans** of cities' pilot actions
- More than **1070 people** were involved in the meetings of the 8 pilot cities: **164 action proposals** and **34 priorities** for waste prevention and management discussed and analysed

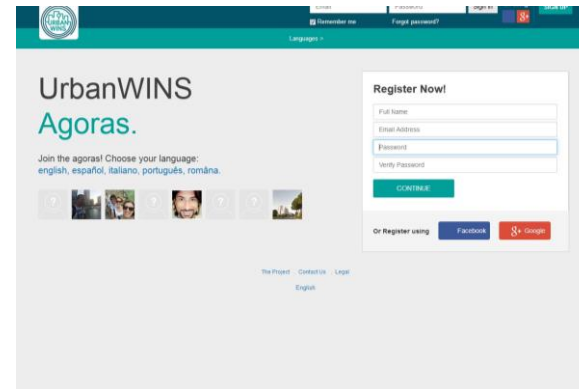

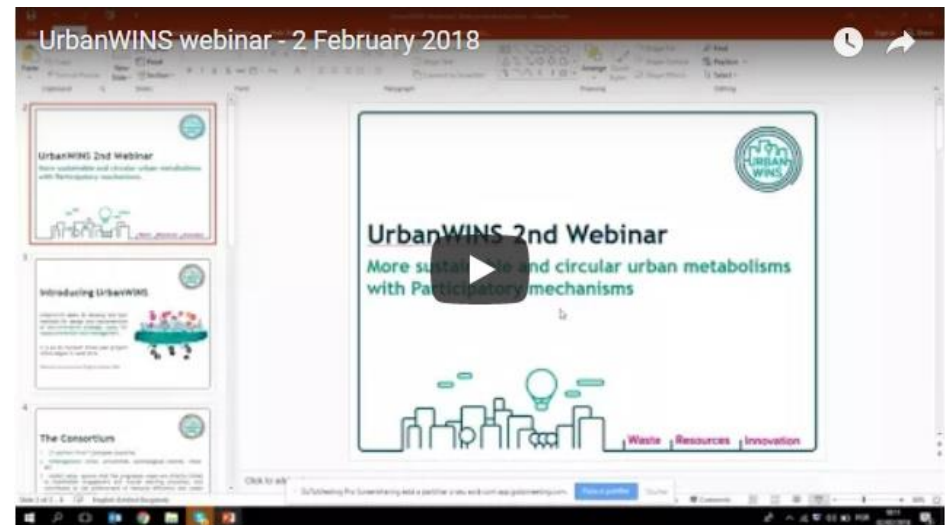
